Des Moines Young Artists' Theatre Explores Life After Neverland lowa Premiere of Lost Girl Opens September 20 at Franklin Jr. High

DES MOINES- You know about the Boy Who Wouldn't Grow Up... but what about the Girl Who Had To? Find out at Lost Girl, presented by Des Moines Young Artists' Theatre at Franklin Jr. High, September 20-29.

Years after returning from Neverland, Wendy Darling (played by Roosevelt sophomore Kiana Collier) decides she must find Peter in order to reclaim her kiss and move on with her life. Along the way, she encounters other girls who went to Neverland and learns she is not alone. A coming-of-age exploration of first love and lasting loss, Lost Girl continues J.M. Barrie's beloved character as she learns to stand in the center of her own story instead of the shadow of someone else's. Winner of the 2018 Kennedy Center Darrell Ayers National Playwriting Award.
